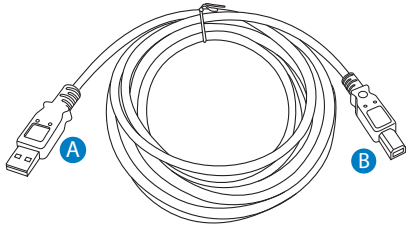

Multi-touch Screen and Laptop set-up

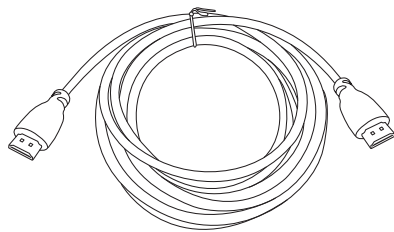
1. Cables

Supplied with your multi-touch screen are various 2 metre cables.

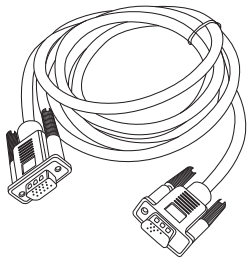
USB A to B cable



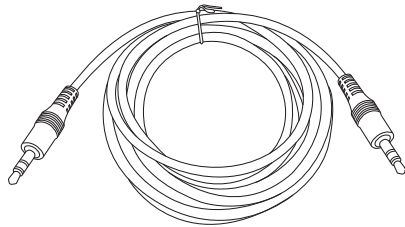
HDMI cable



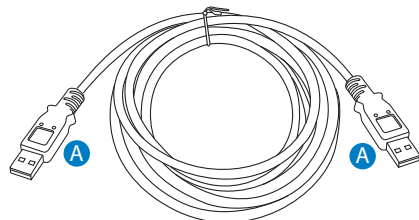
VGA cable

2. Rear panel

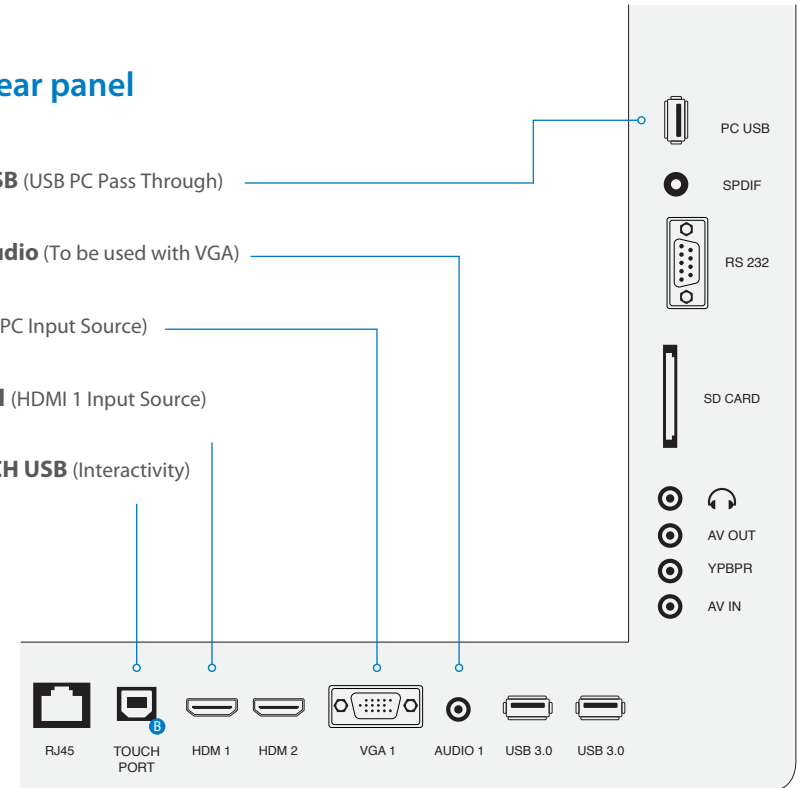
PC USB (USB PC Pass Through)

PC Audio (To be used with VGA)

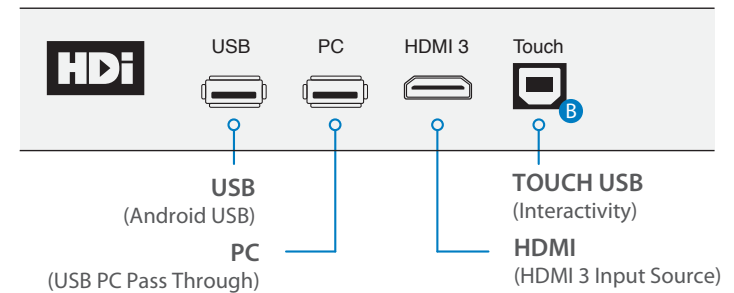
VGA (PC Input Source)

TOUCH USB (Interactivity)

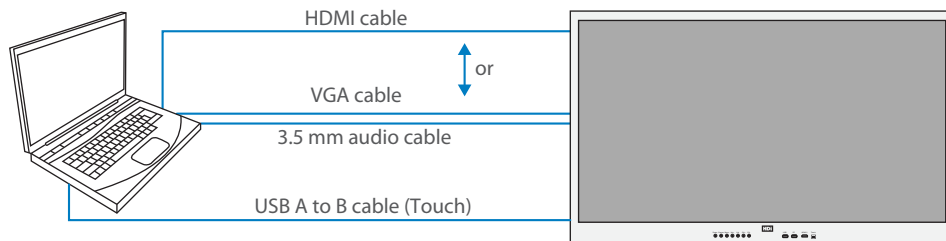


3. Front panel



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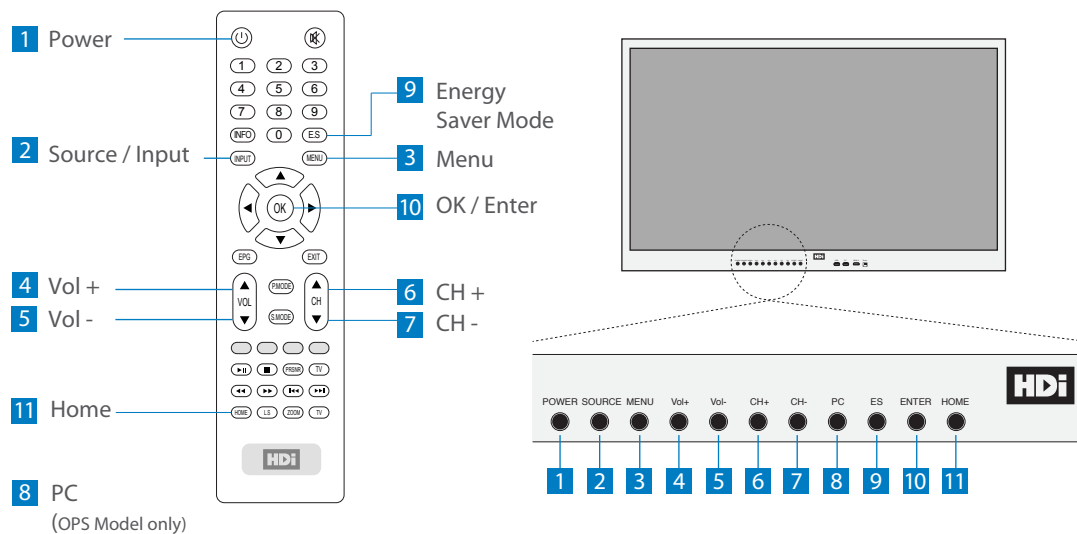
4. Connecting your Multi-touch-Screen and laptop



- Now that you are familiar with the cables, connect the B end of the USB A to B to the front / rear panel socket TOUCH USB. Then connect the A end to your laptop.
- If you are using HDMI, connect the cable to the front / rear panel HDMI socket and to your laptop.
- If you are using VGA, connect the cable to the VGA socket on the rear panel and to your laptop. Then connect the 3.5mm audio cable to the PC Audio socket at rear and to your laptop.

5. Ready to use

You have now connected your multi-touch screen and laptop. Turn on your laptop and multi-touch screen. The multi-touch screen is now ready to use.
