


Multi-touch Screen and Laptop set-up


1. Cables

Supplied with your multi-touch screen are various 2 metre cables.




2. Front panel






4. Wall plate





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
5. Connecting your Multi-touch-Screen and laptop



- Now that you are familiar with the cables, connect the B end of the USB A to B to the wall plate socket USB IN. Then connect the A end to your laptop.
- If you are using HDMI, connect the cable to the wall plate HDMI socket and to your laptop.
- If you are using VGA, connect the cable to the VGA socket on the wall plate and to your laptop. Then connect the 3.5mm audio cable to the MP3 audio socket and to your laptop.

6. Ready to use

You have now connected your multi-touch screen and laptop. Turn on your laptop and multi-touch screen. The multi-touch screen is now ready to use.
