Overview

The HDi Acoustic Presenter Microphone

The HDi Acoustic Presenter Microphone is small enough to fit in a shirt pocket and lightweight enough to be comfortably worn on the included lanyard.

It also includes Page-up/Page-down buttons on the side to make it easier for a presenter to roam the presentation without needing to carry along a "clicker."

The two Page-up/Page-down buttons also serves as a Panic Button – press and hold them both for 3 seconds to trigger a relay on the HDi Acoustic Hub which can be connected to the school's or companies' safety system.

Battery life is 10 hours from a full charge. I A one-hour Quick-Charge provides 4 hours use.

Communications Technology

The HDi Acoustic System uses radio frequency (RF) operating in the 1.9GHz range. No license is required. The Acoustic system automatically selects from 120 channels. This technology enables an abundance of Acoustic Presenter Microphones and Acoustic Audience Microphones to operate in the proximity typical of many schools or meeting rooms.
